# **Bishop Burns speaks to the Guild**

Bishop Burns visited and spoke to members and guests of the Catholic Physicians Guild of Dallas on Tuesday evening, June 18, 2019. The event was held at the Commons at St. Rita Catholic Community. The evening started with a meal catered by Maguire's. Thanks to Gena Maguire and Mayra Thompson for putting together such a nice spread. Bishop Burns' remarks started with encouragement - for us to remain firmly rooted in the faith in the course of performing our profession. He pledged his support for the Catholic Physicians Guild of Dallas. He then talked about a document issued by the Congregation for Catholic Education on June 10, 2019: "Male and Female He Created Them; Towards a path of dialogue on the question of gender theory in education". He noted the threat to Catholic education that exists in our own diocese, citing moral relativism and individualism in the area of human sexuality. The document from the CCE provides a broad outline for addressing gender theory, given in light of guidance from the documents of the Second Vatican Council and the encyclicals of St. John Paul II. The Bishop opened the floor to a Question and Answer format. There was a lively discussion; many pediatricians in the guild have had to address this issue in their practice.

### Next meeting August 6: Can Reducing Harm be Morally Licit?

The next meeting will take place on August 6 at 7:30 PM at the St. Rita Commons. The topic will be a journal club article from the National Catholic Bioethics Center from their May 2019 edition of Ethics and Medics. The article is titled <u>Safe Injection Sites and the Ethic of Harm Reduction</u>, and it evaluates the ethics of offering safe, monitored narcotic injections for drug addicts. That was the model Pope Francis held out to members of the International Federation of Catholic Medical Associates (FIAMC), in his address to delegates on June 21. "Jesus, said the Pope, showed compassionate concern for the sick, leading the early Christian community to call Him a "physician".

He drew near to the sick and disabled, who were often marginalized by their contemporaries as sinners.
