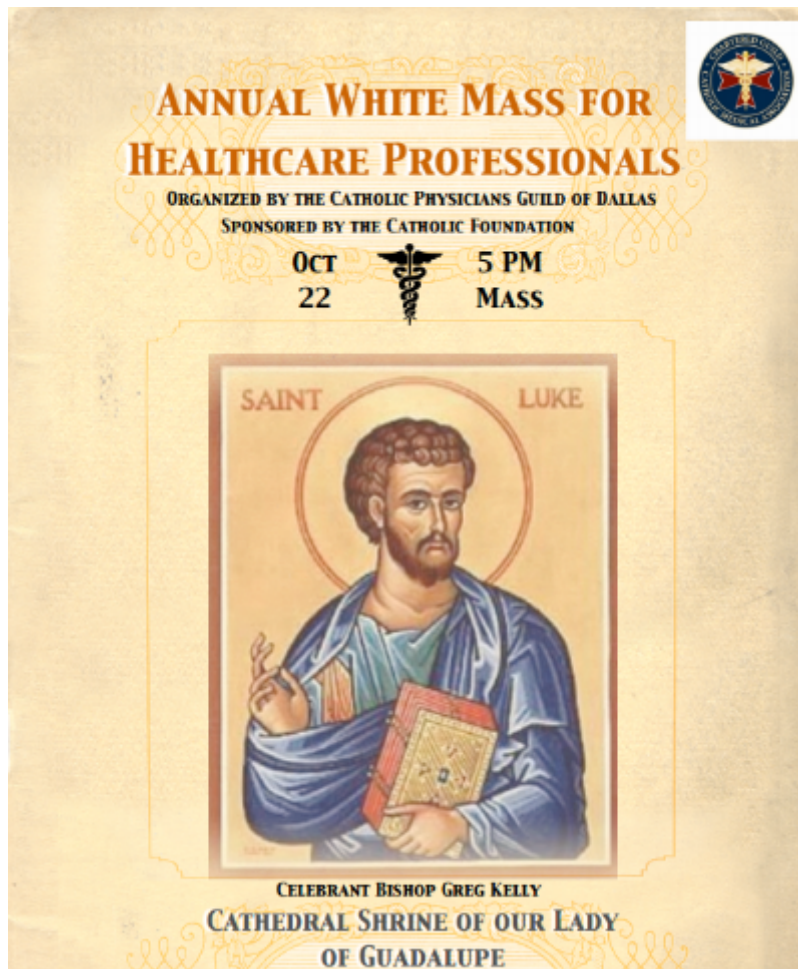

Medical Mission Trip to Nicaragua January 21 thru 27, 2017

A joint medical mission trip between the Diocese of Dallas and Christus Health will take place this coming January to Nicaragua. One Pediatrician and three Internal Medicine or Family Medicine Physicians are needed. Deacon Charlie Stump, chaplain of our Guild, is organizing the mission.

The Mission will be to the community of Santa Marta about 35 miles inland from Puerto Cabezas. Map location:

Nurse Practitioners and Physicians Assistants are welcome along with the need for at least 10 nurses. Bilingual nurses are very welcome. The clinic will have four nurses to run triage (2 alternating at time), one for lab work and at least one in the pharmacy. The nurses will also be assisting the doctors. Each medical team will have at least one bilingual member. The team will be rounded out with lay ministers (non-medical) that number will be 10 to 15 depending on how many are bilingual.
