Dr. Joseph Behan gave a talk on Oct 30th titled <u>The Truth about Contraception</u> and <u>Women's Health Care</u>. "Dr. Behan's talk was very informative as he outlined all the risks associated with using hormonal birth control, including increased risk for breast cancer and infertility," says Sally Diershke, MS2 at UT Southwestern and Co-President of the St. Basil Society. "The discussion included more than the health risks associated with the use of contraception as it turned to the moral implications of a society that devalues family and the gift of being a co-creator with God," Sally added.
